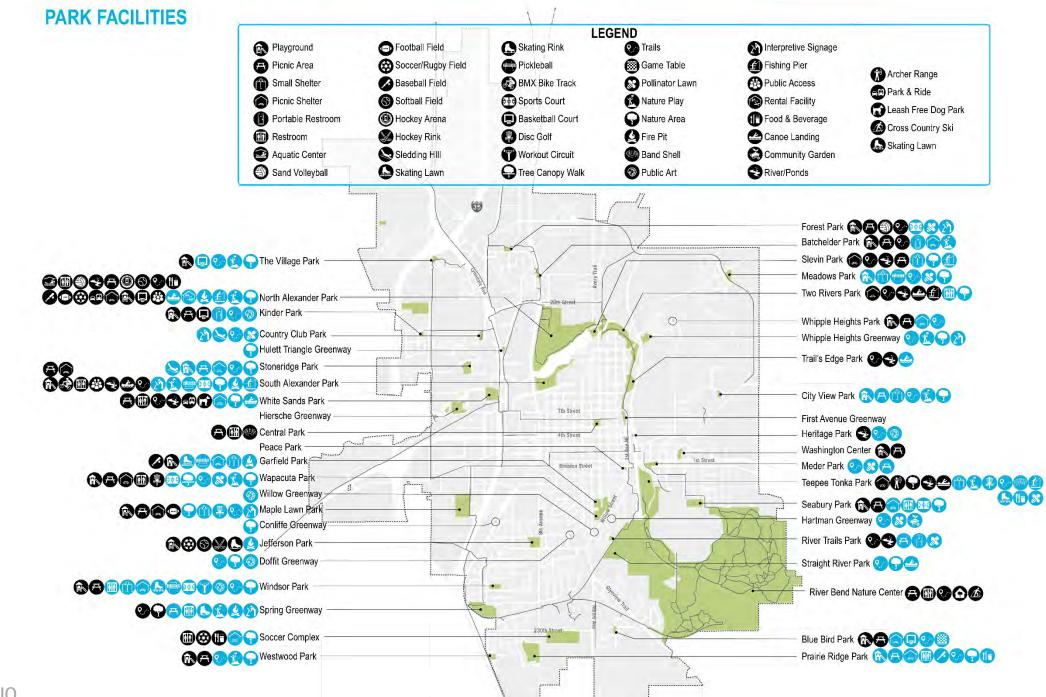






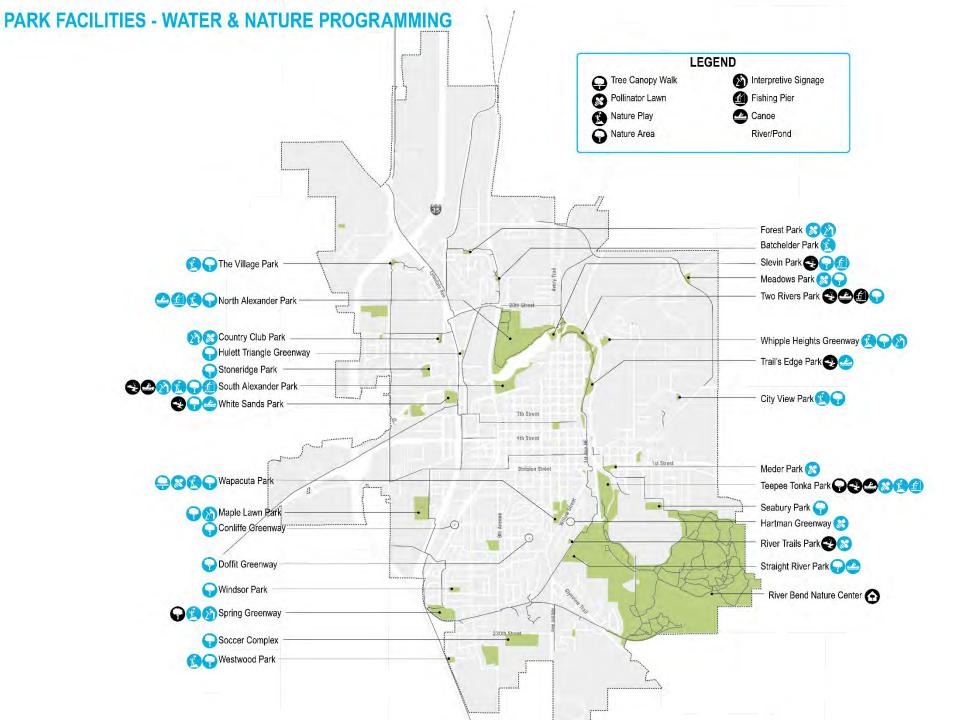


REVIEW OVERALL PARK SYSTEM PLAN



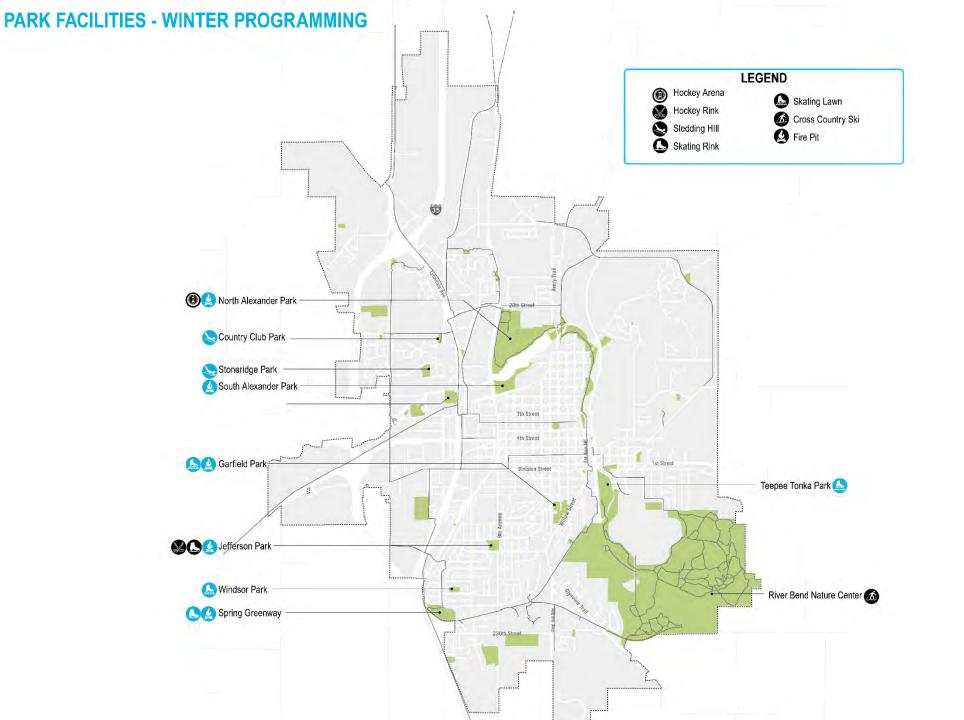

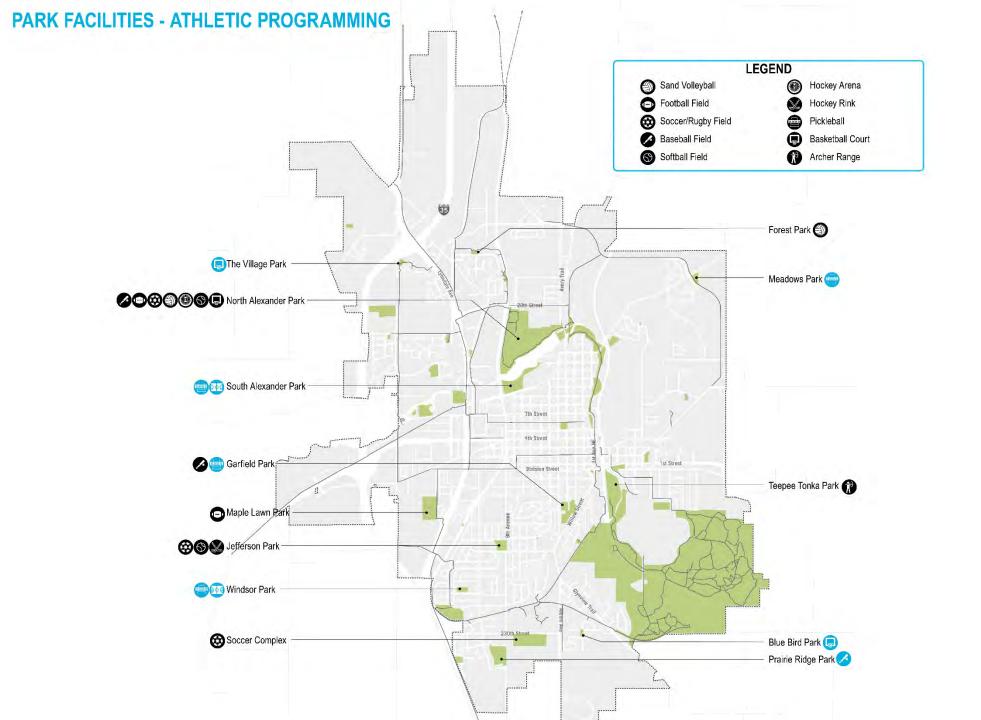

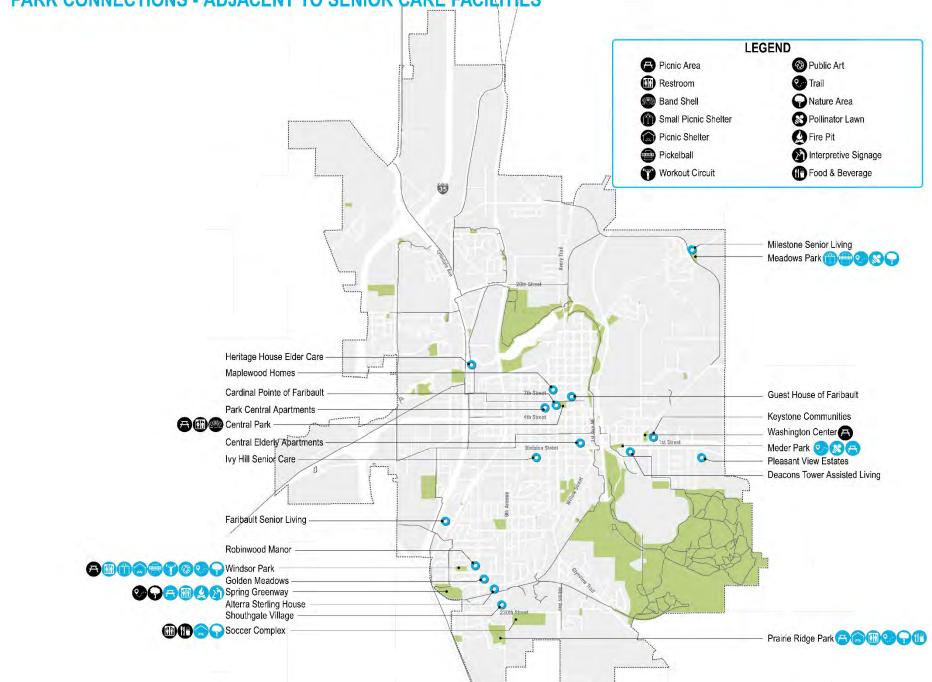

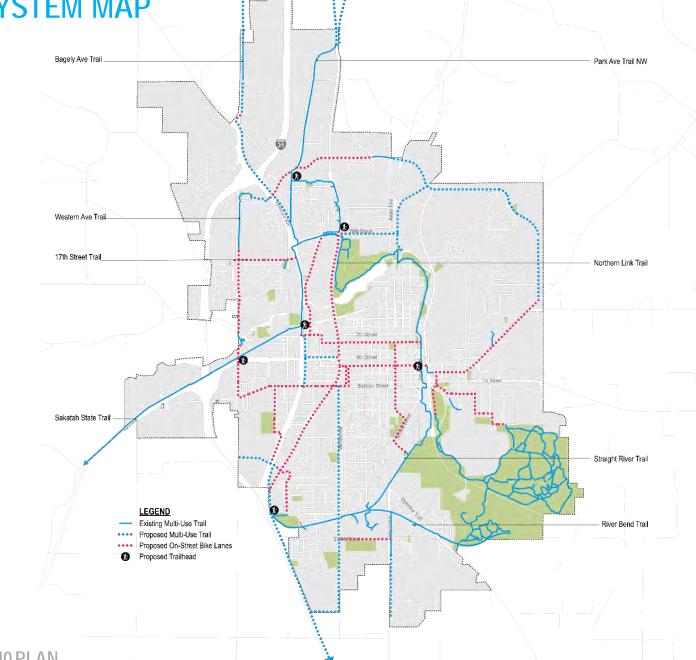

PARK PROGRAMMING INCLUDED IN DOWNTOWN PLAN



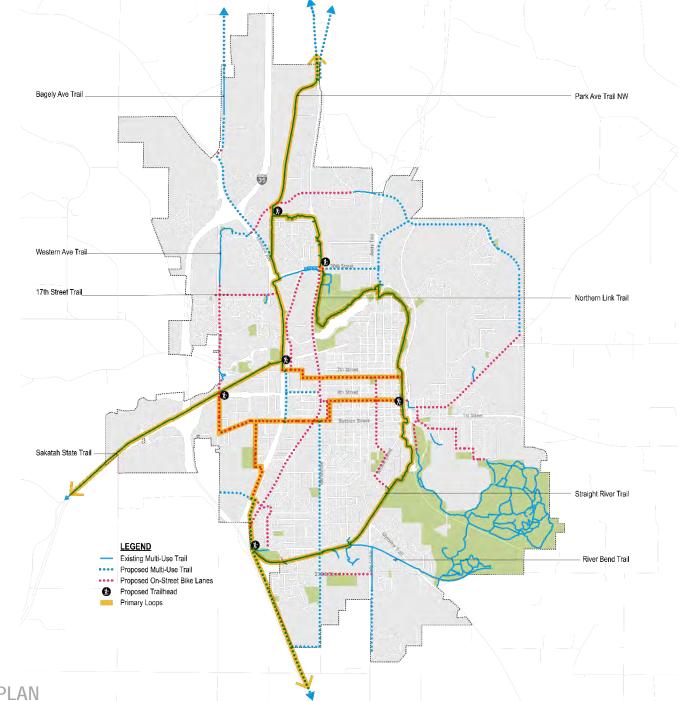
REVISED TRAIL SYSTEM MAP

PRIORITIZATION ACTIVITY

Park programs are organized by relative implementation cost
(\$ Low - \$\$\$\$ High)

2. You will be given "short term Faribault Dollars" and "long term Faribault Dollars"
